

How Long Does It Take To Get rid of hemorrhoids - Do you Know?

How long does it take to get rid of **hemorrhoids**? Well, it depends. There are around 80 per cent of people globally who suffer from hemorrhoids. Women who have had children usually experience hemorrhoids temporarily.

What are hemorrhoids? This is a condition where veins around the anus as well as in the rear end become swollen itchy and inflamed. Hemorrhoids develop from straining any time you require to have a **bowel** movement as well as during pregnancy and by means of chronic constipation or severe diarrhoea as having anal intercourse on a regular basis.



You can develop either internal or **external hemorrhoids** which are also referred to as **piles**. Itching as well as pain and bleeding are usually a sign that one has piles. These are not usually life threatening if treated although issues such as anaemia and other complications could arise should there be uncontrolled bleeding.

- The most notable sign is blood in the feces or bloodstream in the toilet bowl as well as on the toilet paper blood will be noted.
- Inside hemorrhoids may begin to protrude from the anus in which case severe discomfort and also pain will be knowledgeable.
- The hemorrhoids may be hard that will indicate a blood clot and this is referred to as a good thrombosed outside hemorrhoids.

“ When you discover hemorrhoids do not keep rubbing the area due to the itching as well as excess cleaning as this can also cause inflammation and bleeding and will end up in a vicious cycle causing infection. The mucous that drains from his area can also cause severe itching.
